Louis Dion Inc. has been in business since 1979 and specializes in custom wood frame houses. The framing company deals exclusively with homes on the east end of Long Island, NY in the area known as "The Hamptons." The business currently runs five carpentry crews of 12 men each.



Michael Delesia, president of the company, has been using two Manitou telehandlers on his jobs for handling post and beam materials in the construction of the homes that average 12,000 sq. feet. His main reasons in choosing the Manitou models were their compactness, cost, ease of operation and safety features.

Mr. Delesia says "I only regret not acquiring them sooner." The MT models are substantial lifts that will work in tight places and on rough terrain jobsites.



His business has benefited from this choice of telehandlers by not only time savings, but the ability to perform more tasks without additional equipment on the site which has created a safer, more easily managed worksite.
